

TOWN OF MAYFIELD LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 1989

A local law regulating the speed of certain vessels upon the waters commonly known as Mayfield Lake.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Mayfield as follows:

Section 1:

No motor boat shall be operated within 1,500 feet from the shore of that portion of Mayfield Lake located within the Town of Mayfield at a speed exceeding ten (10) miles per hour.

Section 2:

As used in this Local Law, the term “motor boat” shall be deemed to mean and include a mechanically propelled vessel having a source of power other than propulsion by wind, propelled sail or human propelled oar or paddle. The term shall also include a vessel temporarily or permanently equipped with a detachable motor, commonly known as an “outboard” motor boat.

Section 3:

Nothing in this Local Law shall effect or alter the five (5) mile per hour speed limit within 100 feet of shore set forth in Section 45 of the New York State Navigation Law.

Section 4:

A violation of this Local Law shall constitute an offense punishable by a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or by imprisonment for not exceeding ten (10) days, or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 5:

This Local Law shall take effect upon its approval in writing by the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation, and filing with the New York Secretary of State.
