

## **TOWN OF MAYFIELD LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2001**

A Local Law relating to the Abolishment of the Elected Assessor Position and providing for One Appointed Assessor in the Town of Mayfield.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Mayfield as follows:

### **SECTION 1**

Pursuant to the authority granted under Section 328 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the positions of elected assessor in the Town of Mayfield are hereby abolished, effective December 31, 2001, from and after said date there shall be one assessor for the Town of Mayfield, to be appointed as provided in Section 310 of the Real Property Tax Law.

### **SECTION 2**

This Local Law shall be subject to permissive referendum in accordance with the procedures of Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

### **SECTION 3**

Insofar as the provisions of this Local Law are inconsistent with the provisions of any other local law or acts, the provisions of this Local Law shall be controlling.

### **SECTION 4**

This Local Law shall take effect 45 days after its adoption, or if a petition is filed pursuant to Section 24(1) of the Municipal Home Rule Law, upon its approval by a majority of the qualified electors of the Town of Mayfield voting on a proposition therefrom, and upon filing certified copies in the Office of the Secretary of State.
